

## Introduction and Survey Methodology

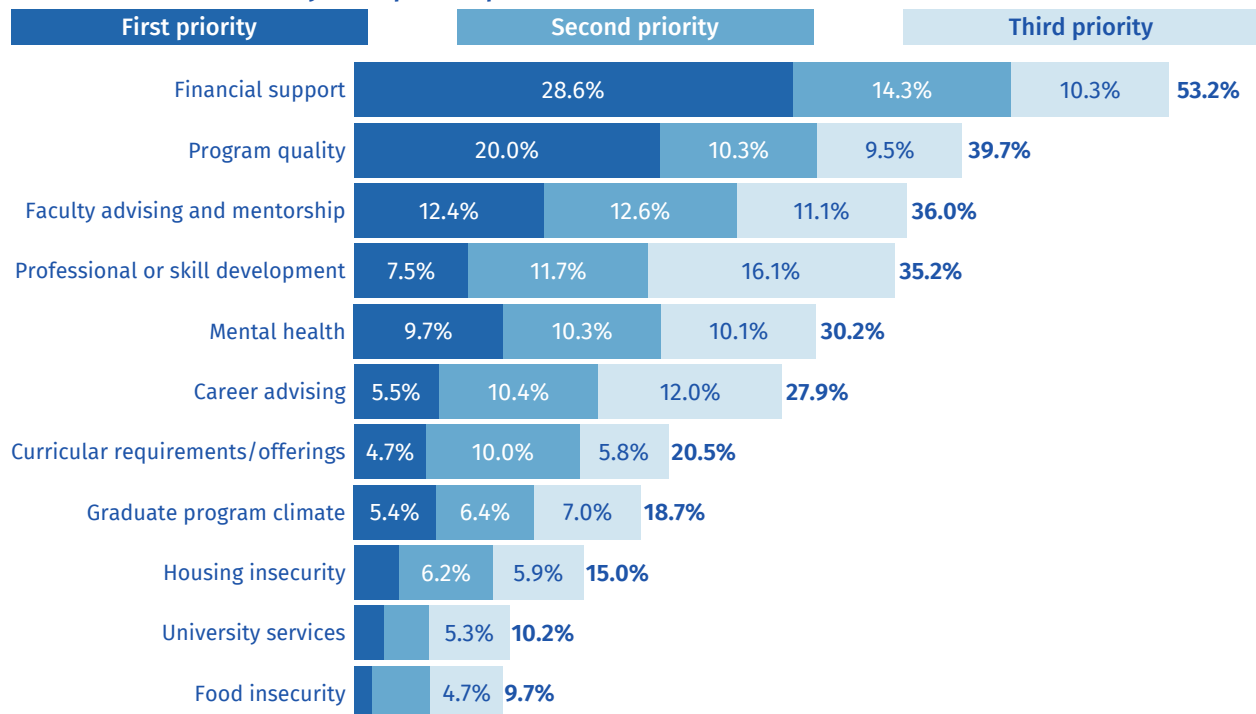
The following is a summary of UCR’s highlights from the Spring 2021 University of California Graduate Student Experience Survey (UCGSES). Administered by the UC Office of the President, the survey covered topics ranging from academic experiences to program climate to well-being and satisfaction. A selection of responses to general-interest questions is provided here; additional items and details may be available on certain topics.

Conducted in April and May 2021, the survey achieved a 40% response rate (1,423 respondents) among UCR graduate students. All active students in all types of UCR graduate degree programs were invited to participate. In terms of both demographics and academic units, respondents were broadly representative of the spring 2021 UCR graduate student population as a whole (see the Respondent Profile section for additional detail).

Unless otherwise noted, the values shown for each question are based on all applicable responses to that question, excluding missing and non-applicable responses.

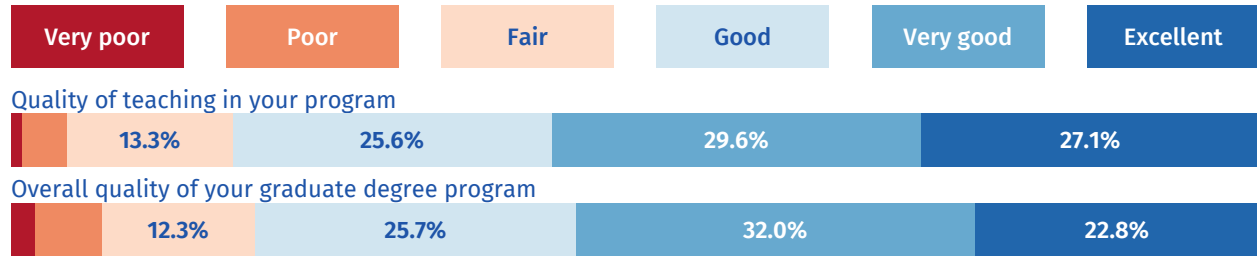
## Graduate Students' Top Priorities

Which of the following would you most like the University to prioritize in regard to attention and resources? Please select your top three priorities.

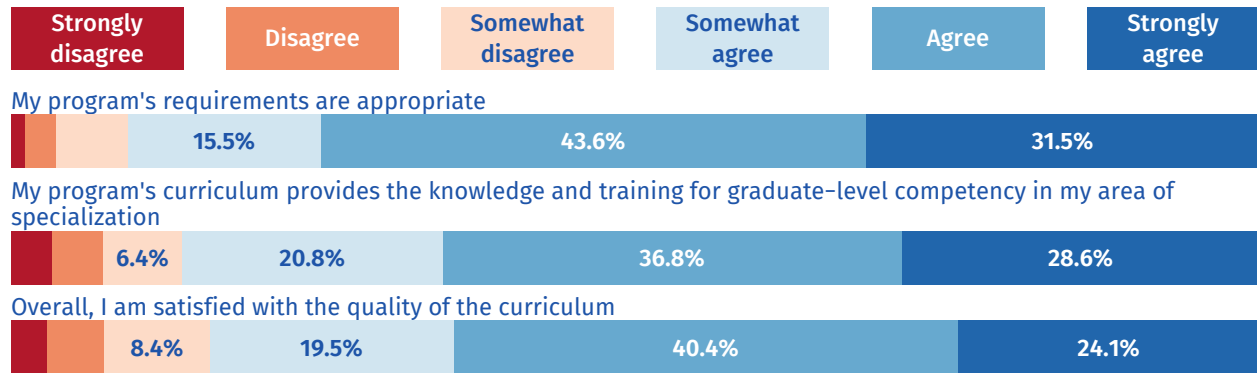

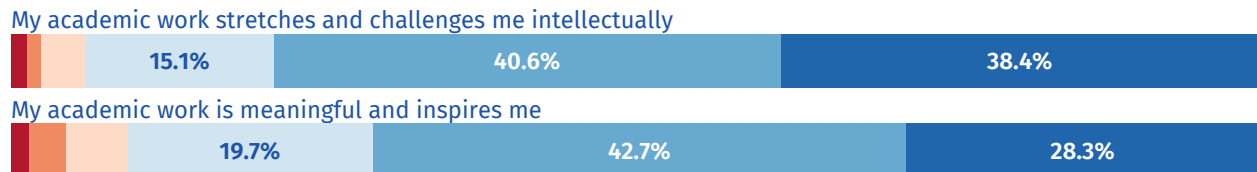

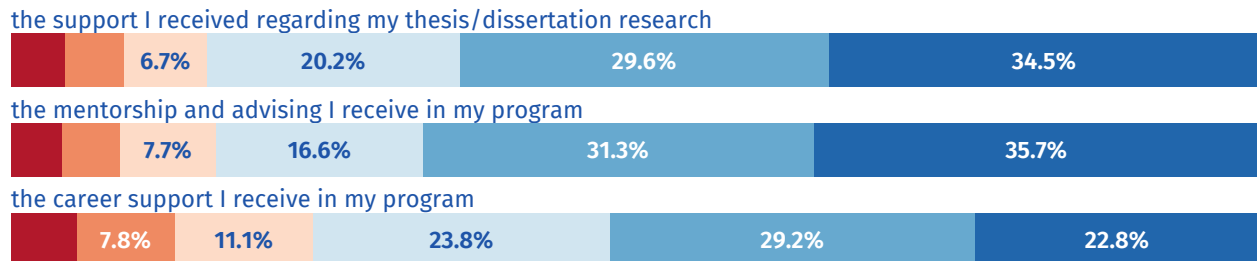

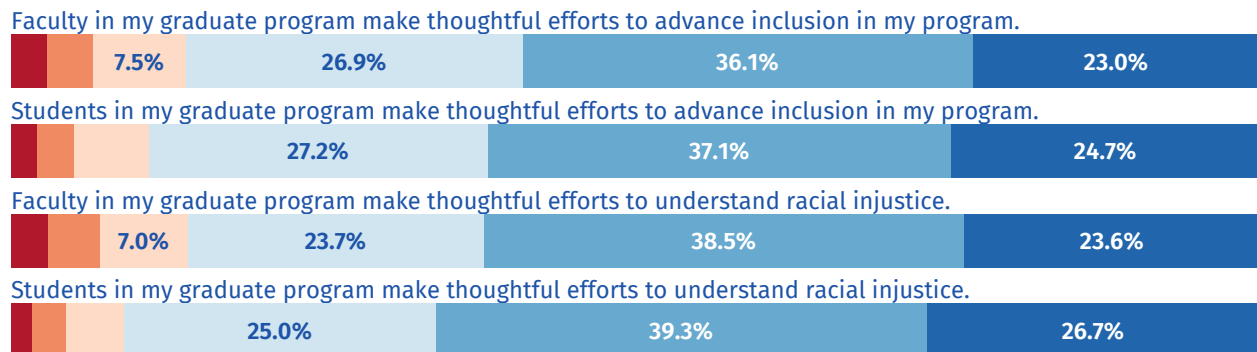

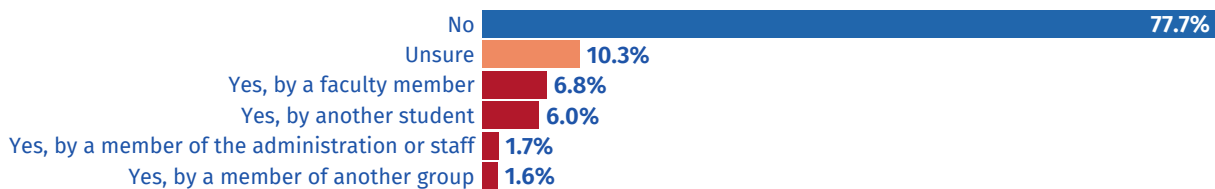
In my graduate program, my culture is respected by...

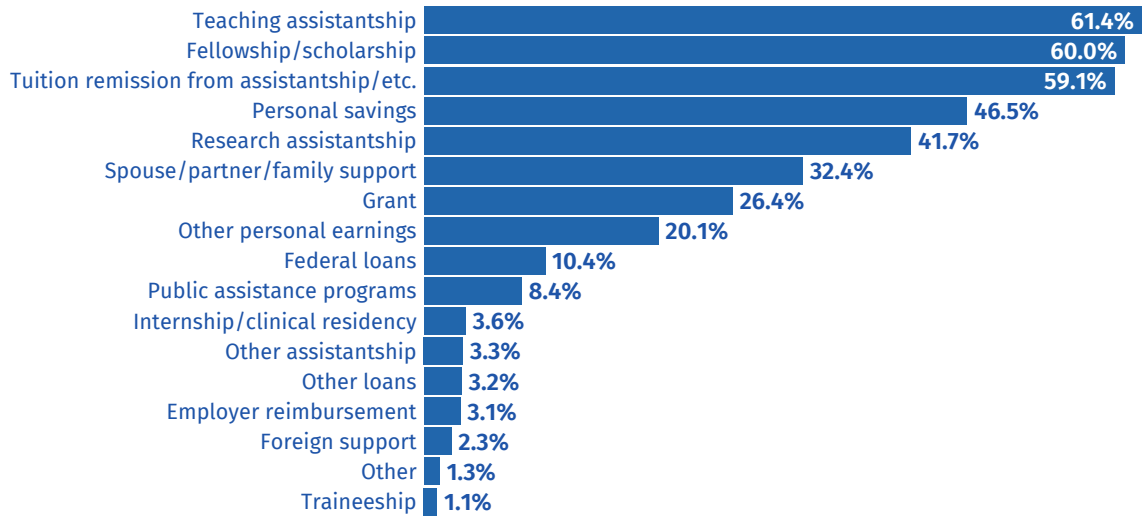


Over the past 12 months, have you been on the receiving end of a significant instance of bias, discrimination, or harassment by someone in your graduate program?

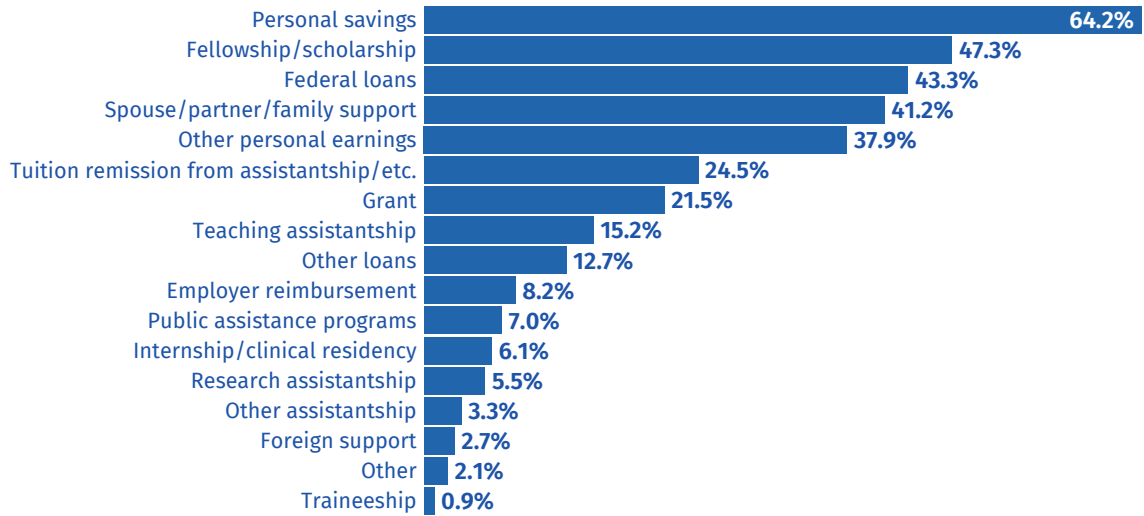

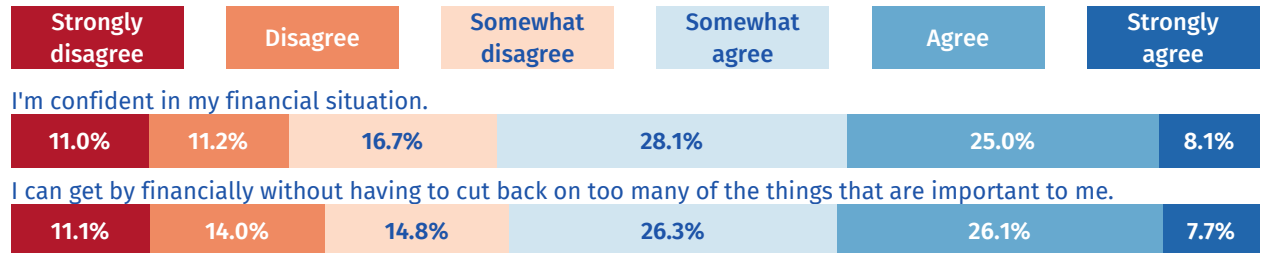
Ph.D. Students: Please indicate which of the following is a source of financial support for your graduate education this academic year.

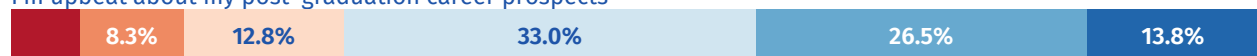

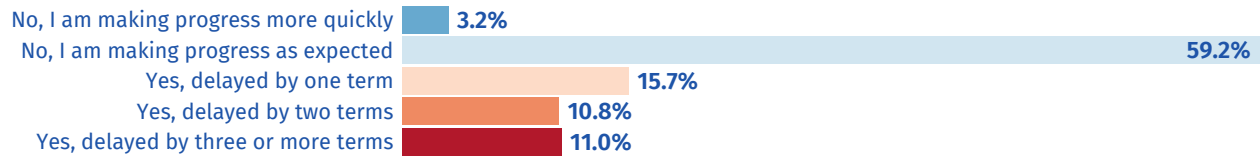

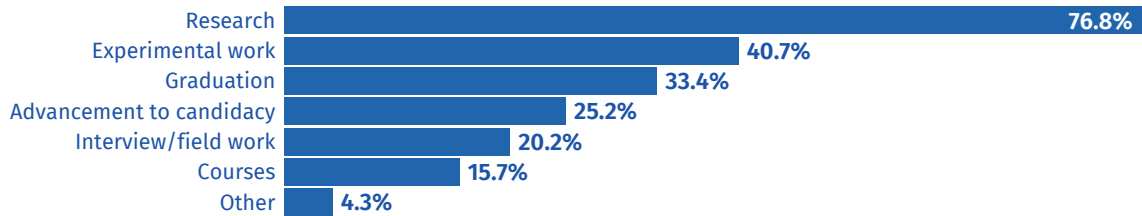

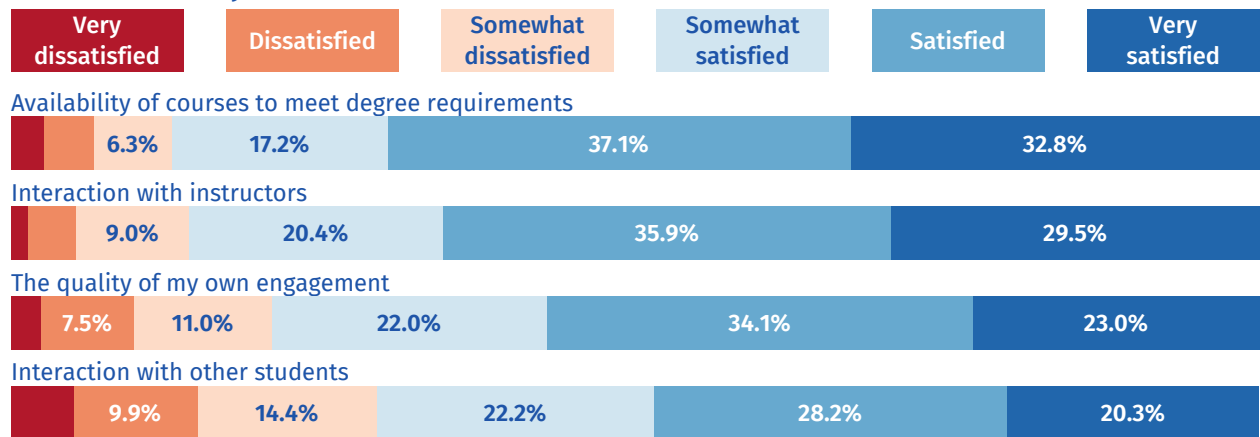
Has progress toward your degree completion been delayed due to the impacts of COVID-19?



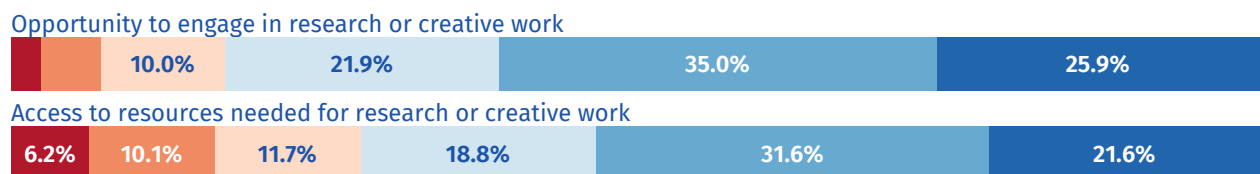
If so, which of the following has been delayed?



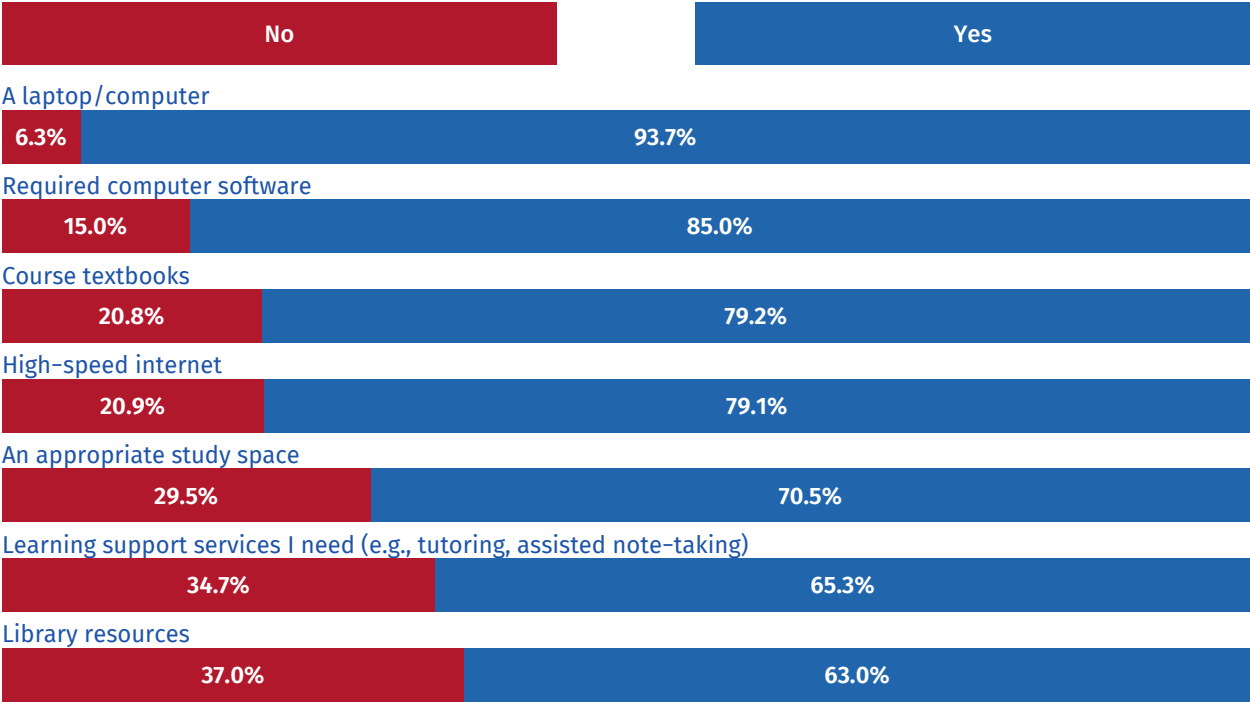
How satisfied are you with each of the following aspects of your graduate coursework during the 2020-21 academic year?



How satisfied are you with each of the following aspects of research or creative work you engaged in during the 2020-21 academic year?

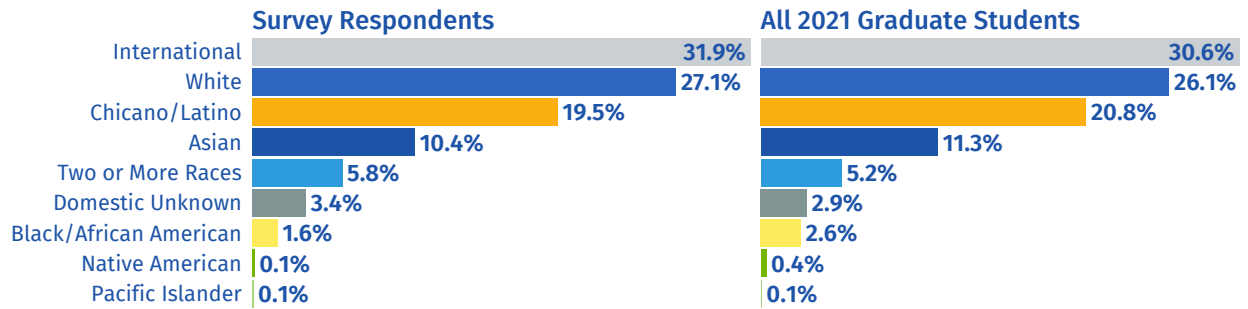


Have you had consistent access to each of the following during your time as a graduate or professional student at UCR during the 2020–21 academic year?

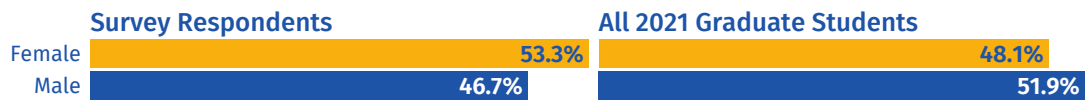

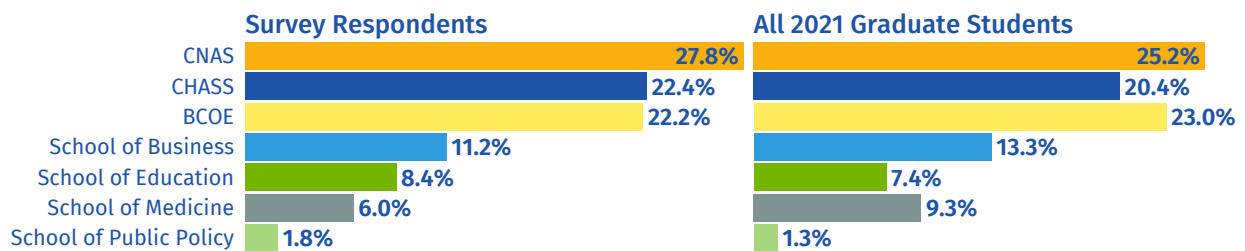
